

The Christ Church

Follow the road for a few meters along Dr Bayer-Straße away from the town and arrive in Kolpingstraße. Here is the protestant Christ Church. It was built in 1912-1913 from designs by Professor Wilhelm Käb in a striking example of art nouveau. Especially worth mentioning are the three colourful church windows round the altar by Gustav Treak of the Royal Bavarian stained glass studio in Nymphenburg and also the gilded crucifix from the workshop of the sculptor Hermann Lang, Munich. The church was renovated in 2010.
