

Ringallee

Past the site of the former Rott gate tower (see foundations), you are led into Ringallee - a chestnut avenue - which runs along the former ramparts of the city. It is unique in Lower Bavaria. With a length of about a kilometre, it circles the town centre and forms, in the truest sense of the word, the Pfarrkirchen „Wall Street“. 365 fruit trees were planted in 1803, poplars were added later and in 1876 the existing chestnut avenue came into being. In the avenue, several fountains and attractive lawns can be found next to the remainders of the old city wall dating from 1558. Consequently in the middle of the town the moods of nature in the change of the seasons can be enjoyed.
