

The late gothic Hospital Grounds & Church

Just beside this is the hospital square with the late gothic hospital grounds and church from the 15th century, documented as a „Citizens Charity Hospital of the Holy Spirit“. In the first half of the 19th century, the church was drastically changed. Worth noting are the neo-gothic high altar and the shrine altar which were probably built before the 19th century. These days the church is used for concerts and to display nativity scenes during the Christmas market and is only open at these times. It was possible for old and frail residents to live and eat in the Hospital of the Holy Spirit free of charge through a charitable foundation.
